

# 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

## WORSHIP

*Sunday Morning Worship* – 1,000 people worshipping together week-to-week

*Service Times* – Changing to 8:30 and 10:30 balanced our attendance, opening space for newcomers

*Easter Sunday* – Over 1,700 people celebrated the resurrection of Jesus

*Advent Lessons and Carols* – 675 people attended two services

*Special Services* – Christmas Eve, RezFasts, Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, Morning & Evening Prayer

*Provincial Assembly* – We hosted the triannual gathering of the entire Anglican Church of North America at Wheaton College, leading pastorally, organizationally, and in worship

## FORMATION

*First Step* – Over 100 people participated in this introduction to Resurrection

*RezKids* – 250 children growing up at Resurrection

*RezYouth* – 100 youth maturing in their identity in Christ

*RezGroups* – 400 people are in 35 groups growing in faith, relationship, and personal mission

*Transformation Intensive* – 100 people are participating in this 8-month rigorous course

*Discipleship* – 80% of the adults in our church are involved in a discipleship program

*Financial and Counseling Assistance* – 35 Resurrection families assisted through times of crisis

## MISSION

*Baptism and Renewal of Baptismal Vows* – 48 people were baptized or renewed their baptismal vows

*Guest Center* – 450 people visited the Guest Center

*Global Mission* – 30 people are supported in 12 countries where the church is not visible or viable

*Alpha* – 3 places to explore the Christian faith for the first time: at Resurrection, at College of DuPage, and at DuPage Jail

*Sanctity of Life* – Saving at-risk infants, supporting at-risk parents, and praying for life

*Replanted* – 77 adoptive and foster families served in Chicagoland; 217 families nationally

*Welcoming Refugees* – 3 families welcomed to our local community through 28 team members

## CHURCH PLANTING

*Pastoral Residency* – Dn. Scott Cunningham completed his residency and John Perrine began residency

*Madison* – Dn. Scott and Marissa Cunningham were sent to plant a church in Madison

*Aurora* – City of Light Anglican Church, launched in 2015, grew to 85 people

*Uptown, Chicago* – Immanuel Anglican Church, launched in 2013, grew to 210 people at two services

*Granddaughter Churches* – Church of the Cross, our first church plant, has planted two churches

## OPERATIONS

*Giving* – Almost \$2.7 million given by 531 families representing 1,290 people (more than ever!)

*A Building for Resurrection and Diocesan Family* – Weddings, birthdays, sports, and more

*A Building for Our Community* – Recitals, concerts, Christian schools, and youth theater

*Moved by Jesus New Initiatives* – Giving will allow facility improvements for our next generation
